

Contractions and Countries

Pronounce: all the contractions. Write and say sentences for each example:

Yes and No Formation

I	am	not
You	are	not
She	is	not
He	is	not
It	is	not
We	are	not
You	are	not
They	are	not

Verb & Negation

is not = isn't
are not = aren't

Contractions

Subject & Verb

I am = I'm
You are = You're
He is = He's
She is = She's
It is = It's
We are = We're
They are = They're

*Contractions are often used in English.

Ex. It is not = It isn't You are not = You aren't I am not = I'm not
or It's not or You're not. am't (does not exist)

C: about nationality



He is from	<u>Canada.</u> (country)
He is	<u>Canadian.</u> (nationality)
They are from	<u>Mexico.</u>
They are	<u>Mexican.</u>
She is from	<u>France.</u> She is <u>French</u>
You are from	<u>Japan.</u> You are <u>Japanese.</u>
We are	<u>American.</u> We are from <u>The United States.</u>

He is from Mars.
He is a Martian.

She is from The Philippines.
I am from Greece.

She is Filipino
I am Greek.

We are from Mexico! We are Mexican!
